Wood Casket Selection



The two main purposes of a casket are to provide the primary protection of the deceased in burial, and to act as a focal point during the services. Therefore, choosing the right casket for yourself or a loved one is a very personal decision.

The value, selection and cost of caskets are affected by a number of factors such as materials of construction, design details and personalization features. Basically there are two types of caskets – wood and metal.

Veteran Burial Benefits

It is our honor at Miles Funeral Home to facilitate burial benefits for our U.S. Veterans. Burial Benefits are available to veterans discharged or separated from active duty under conditions other than dishonorable who have completed the required period of service, and for U.S. Armed Forces members who died on active duty. *All requests, at minimum, must be accompanied by a copy of the deceased Veteran's military discharge papers (DD Form 214).* Benefits include:

Burial in a Massachusetts Veterans' Memorial Cemetery or National Veteran's Cemetery:

The U.S. Government provides a free grave/burial in a Veteran's Cemetery to all those who are eligible. This benefit includes the gravesite, opening and closing of the grave, perpetual care and a Veteran's Marker. The closest Massachusetts Cemetery is Winchendon, MA and the closest National Cemetery is Bourne, MA. We will coordinate the burial as part of the funeral planning process.

American Flag:

As a way to show the Nation's deep gratitude to those, who in times of war and peace have defended our country, the U.S. Government provides an American Flag. We will process the request for you and coordinate the military branch to present the flag at the funeral or burial.

Veteran's Markers or Niche Marker:

The U.S. Government provides free-of-charge a Veteran's Marker for deceased veterans which meet the government criteria. There are various types of markers with most cemeteries in our area accepting flat-bronze or flat-granite. Each cemetery has established their own policy for the type of marker allowed and cemetery installation fees, if any. We will process the request on your behalf and ensure its installation.

Presidential Memorial Certificates:

These Certificates are engraved paper certificates from The White House, signed by our current U.S. President, to honor the memory of an honorable discharged deceased veteran. These Certificates are ordered by us on the Veteran's Marker Application.

V.A. Life Insurance:

Some veterans purchased V.A. Life Insurance when they were discharged from the Military. If you believe your deceased veteran had a life insurance policy, please provide the Veteran's V.A. File Number (policy number) and we will process the claim on your behalf.

Federal Veteran's Burial Benefits:

Burial Benefits may be available if your deceased veteran was receiving disability benefits as a direct result of the veteran's service or who died in a VA Hospital. It is recommended that you contact the local Veteran's Agent for the town/city where the veteran lived to process this request for you. You will need to provide the Veteran's V.A. Claim Number on their disability payments and additional documentation.
