# Itemized Services

## Consultation and Basic Professional Fees \$420

Professional consultation with a licensed funeral director, including but not limited to, expert advice on options to meet your specific needs (24-hour availability).

## Co-ordinating Activities, Rites and Ceremonies \$475

Co-ordination of all activities, rites and ceremonies, before, during and after they have been provided, including services and supplies provided by us, as well as those provided by third party suppliers.

## Documentation – Permits, Forms, etc. \$400

Completion and filing of all documents necessary to carry out the services and supplies requested, including, but not limited to, death registration, burial permit and coroner's certificate for cremation. Assistance with completing government forms, such as CPP death benefit application(s) and health card cancellation. Additional charges may apply for documentation necessary to repatriate a deceased person. Provision of 12 Funeral Director's Proof of Death Certificates issued by Brian E. Wood Funeral Home. Note: Our Funeral Director's Proof of Death Certificates are accepted for most estate settlement purposes, however, occasionally a provincial Certified Death Certificate issued from the Office of the Register General is needed and our staff can assist in completing the application. Also includes memorial donation management

and memorial record on the Brian E. Wood Funeral Home website.

## Transport Remains – Initial within 50km \$250

(Additional fee of \$1.95 per km [one way] added to transfers beyond 50km) Recovery and transportation of the human remains from the location of the remains to the funeral home. (Using a conveyance vehicle \$250.00 / Using a funeral coach/hearse \$300.00)

## Basic Handling and Preparation of Remains \$175

(Requires facilities for preparation/embalming/shelter) The dignified handling of the body for placement into a casket or cremation container, may also include dressing, hygienic care and the setting of facial features for identification without embalming.

## Embalming of remains \$490

(Requires basic handling and preparation of remains, as well as facilities for preparation/embalming/shelter) Embalming is the process of replacing blood and bodily fluids with chemical preservatives. It is a process of sanitation, restoration and temporary preservation and is not legally required, however it may be recommended to preserve the body between the time of death and the visitation or disposition of the deceased. Our professional funeral directors will make a recommendation based on the condition of the body and expected service needs.

## Facilities for Preparation/Embalming/Shelter of Remains \$250

Provincially approved facilities used to shelter and prepare the body.

## Staff Services for Visitation or Private Viewing – Per Hour \$125

Staff to coordinate and oversee the visitation (informal gathering) or private viewing, per hour.

## Facilities and Equipment for Visitation \$500

(Requires staff services for visitation) Designated facilities and equipment used for visitation for a period of up to 4 hours.

## Staff Services for Ceremony \$680

Staff to coordinate and oversee the traditional ceremony or memorial service for up to 3 hours.

## Facilities and Equipment for Ceremony \$450

(Requires staff services for ceremony) Designated facilities and equipment used for the ceremony or memorial service for up to 3 hours.

## General Funeral Home Use \$190

General use of funeral home facility and property for visitations and/or services.

## Funeral Coach/Hearse \$300

Vehicle to transport remains to a ceremony and/or a place of final disposition.

## Conveyance Vehicle to Crematorium \$250

Vehicle to transport remains to and from the crematorium.

## Service Vehicle (Each) \$100

General duty vehicle used to register deaths, move equipment, flowers, etc.

## Clergy/Lead Vehicle \$100

Used to transport funeral director and/or clergy to the location of a service or place of final disposition.

## Pallbearer Vehicle \$100

Van used to transport pallbearers to place of final disposition.

## Limousine(s) At Cost

Rented vehicle used to transport family to the location of a service and/or place of final disposition.

## Additional Mileage \$1.95/km

Mileage for each vehicle traveling beyond 50km from the funeral home will be charged one way only (this is charged per kilometer).

## Statutory Holiday Staffing + 50%

Funerals, burials, visitations, and any staffing related services scheduled for statutory holidays will be charged an additional 50% on all staffing costs.

## Reception Room Facilities \$250

Use of reception room for a luncheon/reception for a period of up to 2 hours. Maximum 125 people. Includes coffee, tea and water. (Note: If the funeral or memorial service takes place in the funeral home the reception room charge is \$190.00)

## Staff for Visitation at an Alternate Location – Per Hour \$150

(Requires a service vehicle) Staff to setup, oversee, manage memorial donations, and use of basic equipment necessary for visitation at a location other than the funeral establishment. This includes 2 staff members and should additional staff be required because of volume of attendees, each additional staff member cost \$50.00 per hour.

## Equipment for a Ceremony or Memorial Service at an Alternate Location \$225

(Requires staff services for ceremony and a service vehicle) Use of specialized equipment (not including required rental equipment) for a ceremony at an alternate location. Use of such equipment will be limited on ceremonies located outdoors.

## Staff Services for Basic Graveside Service \$200

Staff to coordinate and oversee the ceremony and/or interment of a casket or cremated remains burial for up to 1 hour.

## Portable Sound System \$50

(Requires staff services) Use of portable sound system for clergy and/or music at a graveside service.

## Scattering of Cremated Remains \$200

Funeral home staff to scatter cremated remains and/or oversee the scattering of cremated remains in accordance with Ontario and municipal laws and by-laws. Fees for scattering from a plane or boat will be in addition to this charge and will be discussed upon request.

## Refundable Deposit for Cremated Remains \$350

When human remains are to be cremated, a refundable deposit may be required to be paid. If the cremated remains are not claimed within one year of the cremation, the deposit may be used to inter the cremated remains in common ground at a cemetery. If the cremated remains are claimed before one year, the deposit will be refunded.

## Removal of Pacemaker or Implant No Charge

(Requires basic handling & preparation of remains) The removal of a pacemaker or mechanical implant will be carried out by a licensed professional and is mandatory if the human remains are to be cremated.

## Professional Restorative Procedures – Per hour \$90

In some circumstances, additional restorative efforts beyond the standard embalming procedure are necessary to adequately embalm and or enhance the appearance of the deceased. In such cases, the funeral director will discuss the available options.

## Picture Slide Show \$90

Scanning and placing up to 80 photos on a DVD or USB.

## Backdrop Rental for Casket/Urn Setup \$50

(Requires staff services) Use of a 9' high black backdrop for casket or urn setup at an alternate location.

### DISBURSEMENTS

Disbursements are items arranged for and possibly paid for (at cost) on your behalf by the Brian E. Wood Funeral Home. The Purchaser is expected to pay for these items as per the instructions on the funeral services contract. The following are examples of items that are identified as disbursements.

### Coroner's Fee

This is a fee charged by the coroner for issuing a certificate that allows cremation to take place. The fee is set by the Chief Coroner for Ontario.

### Clergy Honorarium

This is an amount paid to the clergy for their services. In some cases, the amount is set by the clergy, in others it is an amount to be determined by the Purchaser.

### Newspaper or Radio Notices

These are charges for death notices placed in newspapers or radio or other media outlets.

### Municipal Death Registration Fee

This is a fee charged by the local municipality to register the death. The fee is set by the municipality and may vary.

### Cremation Fee

Charged by crematorium for cremation process. Brian E. Wood Funeral Home utilizes the services of Georgian Bay Cremation Services in Flesherton, Ontario.

### Church Fees

Some churches have set fees for accommodating funerals.

### Organist/Musicians

A set fee to be paid to musician for playing the organ or piano. Fee may fluctuate depending on the location of the ceremony and if that location has their own organist with their own fee. Bagpipers and soloists also receive payment.

### Cemetery

This is the charge from the cemetery for the cost of opening and closing a grave. Some cemeteries have a separate fee for dressing the grave with greens. Some cemeteries will not bury on Sunday's or holidays and there is often an additional charge for Saturday burials.

### Catering

This is the fee charged for the caterer to provide lunch. The caterer fees will fluctuate depending on the number of people, location, hall rental and the party responsible for making the lunch.

### Repatriation Costs

Depending on the circumstances regarding the repatriation of human remains it might be necessary to appoint a third party specializing in international shipping and repatriations to facilitate the completion of documentation and services.

### Alternative Location Services

Depending on your wishes there can be additional costs for hall rentals, tent(s), sound system, and other miscellaneous equipment rentals. Depending on the circumstances, the Purchaser may be required to pay these fees directly on their own.
